

Statue of Unity with Vadodara 5 Night 6 Days

Day 1: Arrive Ahmedabad

Welcome to Ahmedabad, largest business city of Gujarat, well connected by National Highways, Air Network and Railways. On arrival check in at the hotel. Proceed to visit **Gandhi Ashram**, This was one of the many residences of Mahatma Gandhi who lived at Sabarmati and Sevagram when he was not travelling across India. Visit **Hathising Jain Temple**. Later in the evening proceed to visit **Adalaj Stepwell**. Overnight stay at Ahmedabad.

Day 2: Ahmedabad - Patan - Modhera - Ahmedabad

Enjoy your early breakfast at hotel. Today we will proceed to visit Rani Ki Vav - ('The Queen's Stepwell') - UNESCO's World Heritage Sites, is situated in the town of Patan. Its construction is attributed to Udayamati, daughter of Khengara of Saurashtra. Later we will visit Modhera Sun Temple - is a Hindu Temple dedicated to the solar deity Surya. It was built after 1026-27 CE during the reign of Bhima I of the Chaulukya dynasty. After visit we drive back to Ahmedabad. Enroute visit Akshardham Temple; Swaminarayan Akshardham is a large Hindu Temple complex. Witness the Sat-Chit-Anand Water Show. Overnight stay at Ahmedabad.

Day 3: Ahmedabad – Statue of Unity

After breakfast, proceed to **Statue of Unity** (Kevadia); The Statue of Unity is the world's tallest statue, with a height of 182 metres. It depicts Indian statesman and independence activist Vallabhbhai Patel, who was the first deputy prime minister and home minister of independent India and an adherent of Mahatma Gandhi. Visit **Valley of flowers,** Valley of Flower is spread across 24 acres of land and is a haven for colorful flowering plants. Visit **SoU Viewing Gallery** 153 Metres by high speed elevator. Evening witness **the Light & Sound Show at Statue of Unity**, the colorful laser lighting system is accompanied by an excellent narration of the history and life of Sardar Patel. Later on visit **Glow Garden**. Glow Garden is a park with glowing artifacts. Overnight stay at Kevadia

Day 4: Statue of Unity

Today after breakfast, explore various activities at **SoU**, as per your choice. Overnight stay at Kevadia.

Day 5: Kevadia – Garudeshwar – Pavagarh – Champaner – Vadodara

Post breakfast we proceed to visit **Garudeshwar**, Visit **Pavagadh Archaeological Park**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. It is located around the historical city of Champaner, a city which was founded by Vanraj Chavda, the most prominent king of the Chavda Dynasty, in the eighth century. Proceed to visit Champaner. **Champaner Fort** The heritage site is studded with forts with bastions starting from the hills of Pavagadh, and extending into the city of Champaner. Later proceed to Vadodara. Overnight at Vadodara.

Day 6: Vadodara – Ahmedabad

Vadodara also known as Baroda, is the second largest city in the Indian state of Gujarat. It serves as the administrative headquarters of the Vadodara district and is situated on the banks of the Vishwamitri River. Visit Laxmi Vilas Palace - the magnificent residence of the royal family of Baroda was built by Maharaja Sayajirao Gaikwad III in 1890. In the afternoon proceed to Ahmedabad. Enrotue visit Amul factory, The world famous co-operative dairy 'Amul' is one of the main features of Anand. Amul is the biggest dairy not only in India, but in Asia too. It is owned by thousands of small and medium farmers. Take a guided tour in to the factory. Drop at Ahmedabad airport.

5 Night 6 Days

Tentative Itinerary:

Day 1: Rajkot – Dwarka

Arrive at Rajkot, proceed to Dwarka. Dwarka is one of four sacred Hindu pilgrimage sites collectively called the Chardham and is one of the seven-most-ancient religious cities (Sapta Puri). On arrival visit the Dwarkadheesh Temple. Overnight stay at Dwarka.

Day 2: Dwarka – Bet Dwarka – Dwarka

Post breakfast proceed to Bet Dwarka - A small island off the coast of Dwarka and accessed via Okha. Bet Dwarka is the residence of Lord Krishna. En-route visit Nageshwar Jyotirlinga Temple. After Darshan, return back to Dwarka. Overnight stay at Dwarka.

Day 3: Dwarka - Porbandar - Somnath

After breakfast checkout from the hotel and proceed to Somnath. Enroute at Porbandar visit Kirti Mandir - the birthplace of Mahatma Gandhi. SudamaTemple – the only Temple in the country dedicated to Sudama, the childhood friend of Lord Krishna. After lunch, proceed to Somnath. On arrival, visit Bhalka Tirth, the place where Krishna was killed by an arrow shot by a hunter named Jara. Later proceed to SomnathTemple, dedicated to Lord Shiva, which is said to be the first of the 12 Jyotirlingas in the country. In the evening enjoy Light and Sound Show at Somnath Temple. Overnight stay at Somnath.

Day 4: Somnath - Gir

Today after early breakfast, proceed to Sasan Gir; one of India's oldest sanctuaries and is synonymous with the majestic Asiatic Lion. This is the only place in the world to seeAsiatic Lions in the wild. Explore Gir National Park in evening safari. See Leopards and majestic Asiatic Lions, various species of birds, reptiles like Marsh Crocodile, Spotted Deers, Sambar Deers, Nilgai,. Overnight stay at Gir.

Day 5: Gir – Junagarh

Post breakfast, proceed to Junagarh. On arrival take a Mount Girnar Ropeway ride up to Ambaji Temple. It is Asia's second longest ropeway. After the ride, return back to Hotel. Overnight stay at Junagarh.

Day 6: Junagarh – Rajkot Departure

After breakfast Proceed to Rajkot airport.
