

# Himachal Pradesh 6 Night 7 Days (Chandigarh – Shimla – Manali)

# Tentative Itinerary:

## Day 1: Chandigarh – Shimla

Welcome to the City of Chandigarh-The Capital of Punjab and Haryana and also an Union Territory. Upon arrival at Chandigarh transfer to Shimla popular as Queen of Hills. Enroute visit to Pinjore Garden which is famous for its Mughal style architectural designs. Overnight stay at Shimla.

# Day 2: Shimla & Surrounding

After breakfast proceed to see the beautiful tourist spots around Shimla. One can visit to Kufri which is a small hill station in Shimla, famous for its natural and scenic beauty. In Kufri one can visit Kufri Adventure Park and Kufri Zoo. Also visit to Jakhu Hills which has a historic significance since Ramayana. Jakhu Hills as a 108ft tall Hanuman Statue. Later on return back to Shimla, evening stroll at Mall road - most of Shimla& landmarks are located here like Christ Church and Scandal Point at the end. Overnight at Shimla.

# Day 3: Shimla – Manali

After breakfast check out from hotel and proceed to Manali which is famous for snow capped mountains, picturesque valleys. Enroute pass by Pandoh Dam and Scenic Kullu Valley. Visit Kullu Shawl factory outlet. On arrival check in at hotel. Overnight stay at Manali.

# Day 4: Manali – Snow point / Rohtang

Today proceed to the Snow Point / Rohtang Road, enroute enjoy breathtaking views of snow- capped mountain vistas, beautiful meadows, glaciers and winding rivers. On arrival get a chance to enjoy in the snow, take pictures. Later return back to Manali. Overnight at Manali.

## Day 5: Manali – Atal Tunnel – Solang Valley – Manali

After breakfast proceed to visit famous Atal Tunnel, a highway tunnel built under the Rohtang Pass in the eastern Pir Panjal range of the Himalayas. Later on proceed to Solang Valley. This is famous for hosting various adventure sports like Zorbing, ATV rides, paragliding, etc. On the way back visit Vashisht Kund - known for its hot sulphur springs. Later visit Hidimba Devi Temple - it has historical and archaeological importance, the temple is dedicated to Goddess Hidimba. Evening enjoy at Mall Road which offers several options for shopping. Overnight stay at Manali.

## Day 6: Manali – Chandigarh

After breakfast, proceed to Chandigarh. Check in to Hotel. Overnight stay at Chandigarh.

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### Day 7: Chandigarh Departure

After breakfast check out from hotel and proceed for Chandigarh sightseeing if time permits. Visit Rock Garden - a sculpture garden for rock enthusiasts, Zakir Hussain Rose Garden - Asia& largest rose garden spread over 30 acres. Also visit Sukhna Lake. After sightseeing drop at Airport / Railway station. Vacation comes to an end with good memories that will last forever.

(10Nights/11 Days || Shimla, Manali, Dharamshala, Dalhousie, Amritsar)

# TENTATIVE ITINERARY DAY 01 DELHI -SHIMLA (APPROX 345 KMS)

Pick up from Delhi Railway Station/Airport and proceed to Shimla .Arrival at hotel and evening with the mall, The Church, The Ridge, The Scandal point & Lakkar Bazaar. Back to hotel and Overnight at hotel.

# DAY 02 FULL DAY KUFRI SIGHTSEEING

After breakfast proceed for Shimla Full day Shimla Kufri sightseeing with Green Valley, Fagu Valley, Indraprastha Park, Mini Zoo & Fun world. Over night at Hotel.

# DAY 03 SHIMLA-MANALI (APPROX 250KMS)

After breakfast drive from Shimla to Manali with Sightseeing of Sunder Nagar Lake, Pandoh Dam, & Hanogi Temple. Arrival at Manali Hotel. Overnight at hotel.

# DAY 04 MANALI – LOCAL SIGHT SEEING

After Breakfast proceed to Manali Half day Local sightseeing with Hadimba Temple, Club House, Vashisht Temple, Van Vihar & Tibetan Monastery. Dinner and overnight at Manali.

# DAY 05 FULL DAY SOLANG VALLEY (ROHTANG PASS ON EXTRA COST)

Hotel After breakfast proceed to Full day Sightseeing Nehru Kund, and Solang Valley, and enjoy there adventure activities such as Skiing, Snow Scooter, Tube Ridding, Horse ridding & Rope Way (Activities are not include in the package.). Evening back to Hotel and overnight at Hotel.

# DAY 06 MANALI – DHARAMSHALA (APPROX 240KMS)

After breakfast check out from hotel and proceed to Dharamshala. On arrival in Dharamshala visit Bhagsunag Temple and Dalai Lama Monastery, Later visit Dharamshala Stadium (Subject to operation), War memorial. Enjoy shopping at Macleodganj Bazaar.

## DAY 07: DHARAMSHALA - DALHOUSIE

Visit Jwalaji Temple at Jwalamukhi, Kangra fort, Namgyal monestry. Later visit Aghanjar Mahadev Temple. Evening proceed to Dalhousie for overnight stay.

# DAY 08: DALHOUSIE - KHAJIAR - CHAMBA - DALHOUSIE

Proceed to Chamba. See Ajit Singh Smarak, Visit Khaijar Lake, Rang Mahal , Dainkund peak, St.John's church, Pass by Chaugan and Satdhara Waterfall.

# DAY 09: DALHOUSIE - AMRITSAR (APPROX 200KMS)

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After breakfast proceed to Amritsar. After fresh N up proceed to Sightseeing Golden Temple-the most important sikh shrine which is also called Mecca for the Sikhs is a living symbol of the spiritual and historical traditions of the Sikhs. Then visit Jallianwala Baghwhere, on April 13, 1919, British and Gurkha soldiers opened fire on an unarmed forbidden gathering, killing hundreds of civilians. Evening Return to hotel. Over night stay in Amritsar.

### **DAY 10: AMRITSAR**

After fresh N up proceed to Sightseeing Indo-Pak Wagah Border to watch Flag Retreat Ceremony Wagah, an army outpost on Indo-Pak border 30 Kms from Amritsar where the daily highlight is the evening "Beating the Retreat" ceremony. Soldiers from both countries march in perfect drill, going through the steps of bringing down their respective national flags. As the sun goes down, nationalistic fervor rises and lights are switched on marking the end of the day amidst thunderous applause Return to hotel. Over night stay in Amritsar.

### DAY 11: DEPARTURE

After breakfast check out from hotel and drop at Amritsar airport for your return flight.



# Dalhousie - Dharamshala - Palampur - Amritsar (6 Nights/7 Days)

**Tentative Itinerary:** 

### Day 1: Amritsar Arrival and transfer to Dalhousie

Arrival at Amritsar and proceed to Dalhousie. Overnight stay at Dalhousie.

### Day 2: Dalhousie – Khajjiar – Chamba- Dalhousie

Proceed to Chamba. See Ajit Singh Smarak, Visit Khaijar Lake, Rang Mahal , Dainkund peak, St.John's church, Pass by Chaugan and Satdhara Waterfall.

### Day 3: Dalhousie to Dharamshala

Proceed to Dharamshala. On arrival in Dharamshala visit Bhagsunag Temple and Dalai Lama Monastery, Later visit Dharamshala Stadium (Subject to operation), War memorial. Enjoy shopping at Macleodganj Bazaar.

### Day 4: Dharamshala

Visit Jwalaji Temple at Jwalamukhi, Kangra fort, Namgyal monestry. Later visit Aghanjar Mahadev Temple.

### Day 5: Dharamshala – Palampur

On arrival at Palampur, visit Saurabh van vihar, Neugal khad bridge, Palampur tea gardens, Jakhni mata temple. Overnight stay at Palampur

### Day 6: Palampur to Amritsar

Proceed to Amritsar. On arrival visit Jallianwala Bagh - noted for the most infamous massacre under British Raj. Visit Golden Temple - the holiest shrine of Sikh religion. Visit Gobindgarh fort.

### **Day 7: Amritsar Departure**

After breakfast check out from Amritsar hotel and drop at Airport for your return flight.



# Spiti Valley with Sangla (8 Night/9 Days)

### **Tentative Itinerary:**

### Day 1: Arrive Chandigarh – Shimla

On arrival at Chandigarh, proceed to Shimla - one of the most stunning hill stations of India situated at an altitude of 2,205 meters, it used to be the summer capital of British India & is the current capital of the state of Himachal Pradesh with a well-planned architecture. On arrival check in at hotel. Overnight stay at Shimla.

### Day 2: Shimla – Kalpa

Today after breakfast proceed to Kalpa. Kalpa is a small town in Kinnaur district. It & nestled in the Sutlej river valley making it an ideal vacation spot. Most visitors stumble on to this place on their way to the famous Spiti Valley. Seekers must climb 16 km of steep narrow road from the Shimla Kaza highway. On arrival check in at hotel. Overnight stay at Kalpa.

### Day 3: Kalpa – Tabo

Today after breakfast Check out from hotel and proceed to Tabo. Enroute we visit Tabo Monastery. Tabo Monastery Often referred as Ajanta of the Himalayas which is also a UNESCO World heritage site. Monastery is situated at the height of 10,007 feet in Lahaul and Spiti district of Himachal Pradesh in north India. It is one of the oldest Buddhist pilgrimage centres in the Trans-Himalayas region. Held in high regard by Tibetan Buddhists, Tabo is second in importance to the Tholing Gompa in Tibet. On arrival check in at hotel. Overnight stay at Tabo.

### Day 4: Tabo – Kaza

Today after breakfast proceed to Kaza. After comfortable night rest,

we hit the road again and will be travelling from Tabo to the main administrative town of Spiti Valley, Kaza on this day. Enroute we visiting Dhankar Monastery which is situated at an elevation of 12,774ft above the sea level. Built on spectacular cliffs overlooking the confluence of Spiti and Pin rivers. Dhankar Monastery was once the capital of Spiti in 17th century. It is one of the five main Buddhist centres and tourist destinations in Spiti region. Dhankar Monastery provides the most scenic views of the valley. We will also be visiting the Pin Valley. On arrival check in at hotel. Overnight stay at Kaza.

### Day 5: Kaza – Kibber – Hikkim Village – Kaza

Today after breakfast proceed to visit Kye Gompa. Key Gompa is famous places around Kaza like which is a Tibetan Buddhist monastery of the Gelugpa sect located on top of a hill at an altitude of 4,166 metres (13,668 ft above sea leval. Later we proceed to visit Kibber Village also knows as Kyiber Village high in the Spiti Valley in the Himalayas at 4270 metres or 14,200 ft in Himachal Pradesh in northern India. We will also visit the famous Lord Buddha statue in Langza Village and will travel further up on this route towards Komic and Hikkim village which are famous for being the world's highest motorable Village and World& Highest Post office respectively. Later we proceed to Kaza.

### Day 6: Kaza – Tabo

After breakfast start your return journey. Proceed to Tabo. Evening for leisure. Overnight stay at Tabo.

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### Day 7: Tabo – Sangla – Chitkul – Sangla

Post breakfast transfer to Sangla. After fresh n up, proceed to visit Chitkul, hidden in the lap of Himalayas. Chitkul is called the last village in India. It is mainly known for its mesmerizing beauty and nature. The picturesque location and the scenic beauty of the place are what draws travelers towards it. Lateron come back to Sangla, a town in the Baspa Valley, also referred to as the Sangla valley, in the Kinnaur District of Himachal Pradesh. Overnight stay at Sangla.

### Day 8: Sangla – Shimla

After breakfast proceed to Shimla. In the evening one can stroll at Mall road - most of Shimla & landmarks are located here like Christ Church and Scandal Point at the end. Overnight stay at Shimla.

### Day 9: Shimla – Chandigarh Departure

After breakfast tranasfer to chandigarh airport Railway station. Vaccation comes to an end with beautiful memories.

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
