

Cambodia 5 Night 6 Days

Tentative Itinerary:

Day 1: Arrival at Phnom Penh

Upon arrival at Phnom Penh Airport, you will be welcomed by our driver only and transferred to hotel. Free for your own time at leisure. Overnight in Phnom Penh.

Day 2: Phnom Penh

After breakfast We start to visit the private quarters of the Royal Palace, Silver Pagoda the most sacred shrine in the country. We visit both structures as well as the legendary temple of Wat Phnom which recites the history of Phnom Penh's name. Today is a full day exploring Phnom Penh. Lunch not included.

Explore the Tuol Sleng Prison Museum a visit to this site provides us a deep insight into the painful bloody rule of the Khmer Rouge. Free time for shopping at Russian Market (Phsar Tuol Tompong). Overnight in Phnom Penh.

Day 3: Phnom Penh – Siem Reap

After breakfast transfer to Phnom Penh Airport for your departure by domestic flight to Siem Reap. Upon arrival, you will be picked by our driver only and transfer to your reserved hotel. Evening time free for leisure. Overnight in Siem Reap.

Day 4: Siem Reap, Angkor Thom and Angkor Wat temples

After breakfast visit the "Great City" of Angkor Thom, visits include the famous Bayon Temple, Phimeanakas Temple within the Royal Palace enclosure, Baphuon Temple, the Terrace of the Elephants and the Terrace of the Leper King.

Afternoon dedicated to visit the most famous & magnificent Angkor Wat temple. This architectural masterpiece was constructed in the 12th century and covers an area of about 210 hectares. With many galleries with columns, libraries, pavilions, courtyards and ponds full of water, carved low-reliefs about Ramayana Story and day-to-day life at the time of Angkor's construction. At the end of afternoon, we will do sunset over Pre Rup temple. Overnight in Siem Reap.

Day 5: Reap

After breakfast enjoy a boat ride on the Tonle Sap Lake. This is the largest permanent fresh-water lake in South East Asia and flows into Tonle Sap River, joining the Mekong in Phnom Penh. We will see a fishermen's "floating village" with floating schools, floating police station, etc. It is same as a big village floating on the lake, and the "village" move from place to place following water levels and current. On the way back we will take sometimes to visit the famous Handicraft school of Artisan d'Angkor and the local Market of Phsar Chas. Afternoon, we will discover the Silk Farm in Puok, established by a French NGO to revive Cambodia's beautiful silk production. We can see every step of silk production; Barray Occidental and a small abandoned temple Ohk Yum. Overnight in Siem Reap.
